FINANCIALS

MMCTV is a 501(c)3 nonprofit largely funded by cable company Comcast, as mandated by Federal and State law. In 2016, we had \$141,356 in operating and \$13,739 in capital revenue. Here is the breakdown of our 2016 **expenses**.

In 2017, we are tentatively budgeting for the significant (est. \$30,000) cost of adding a 2nd channel, pending Comcast approval. Our board approved a budget of \$151,402 in operating and \$44,785 in capital expenses.
